Thank you for your request for information made under the Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) 2000 relating to Cost of painting new lines on Maidstone roundabout. Please see the response provided below:

Please can you provide the cost of the recent repainting of the roundabout on Royal Engineers Road in Maidstone? If available, please can you also say what it would have cost to repaint it as a normal roundabout rather than the 'turbo' style chosen.

Kent County Council can confirm that the total cost of the crash remedial scheme to install the new lining and surfacing measures at Stacey's Street / A229 roundabout junction was £79,500.82, inclusive of traffic management costs and all physical works. Unfortunately, KCC does not have detailed costs of how much resurfacing and refreshing the previous road layout would have been as this would require a separate scheme design and quotation process to be carried out.

If you are unhappy with this response, and believe KCC has not complied with legislation, you have 40 working days from the date of this response to ask for a review.
